Language Arts	<p>Language Arts is broken down into:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grammar - Writing complete sentences, parts of speech, summarizing, paragraph writing, and creative writing • Literature - Through the textbook series, novels, and picture books. We will do workbook pages for reinforcement.
Math	Adding, subtracting, multiplication, division, counting money, measurement, geometry, fractions, telling time, and temperature
Religion	The theme for this year is "Kindness and Respect." We act this way every day in our classroom. We will talk about Jesus giving us the Church, that we are members of the Church, the Church leading us to worship, and that we are called to be disciples. We also send letters to the homebound elders.
Science	We learn how plants and animals interact, Students participate in a reptile (3 rd quarter) exhibit and a amphibian (4 th quarter) exhibit. We explore Earth's land, experience what it is like to be handicapped, investigate matter, explore energy and forces, and participate in the annual "Invention convention" at St Rita.
