



Religion - Grade 5 and Grade 6

The study of Religion at St. Rita of Cascia School is a very important subject. Our students are expected to live the lessons Jesus gave to us during his life, death and Resurrection. The students will learn about the Old and New Testament which includes the life Jesus lived as an example to all Christians. We use the We Believe (textbook) series published by Sadlier.

Daily work may or may not be completed in class. Homework will usually be assigned two to three times a week. Look for the *Family Pages* at the end of each chapter. This is always homework and I expect that a *parent or guardian will need to read and sign the page*. Students will have a test of some type from each chapter of the textbook.

Students work is weighted in this manner, and, if there is a change, a notice will be sent home.

- Tests - 50%
- Projects - 10 %
- Homework - 20%
- Participation - 20%

I allow students to correct tests to earn back one half of the points they missed. In order to earn the points the students must: 1) Staple a piece of notebook paper to the top of the test. 2) Find the answer in the book and write the correct answer on a sheet of paper and include the page number. 3) Have a parent or guardian sign the test. All of this must be accomplished within five (5) days after the test is returned.

Extra credit is available to students who complete all of the regular classroom work and homework. I will also point out extra credit opportunities to the students as we move through the textbook.
